Recent changes have been made to the aggregate certifications. The TTCP program will continue to offer two levels of aggregate certification; however, the courses have been restructured to the following:

Aggregate Sampler - formerly Level I Aggregate

Aggregate Technician - a combination of the former Level I and Level II Aggregate certifications

Formerly:

Course name	Class duration	Pre-requisite	Recertification class
Level I Aggregate	0.5 day	None	0.5 day
Level II Aggregate	3.5 days	Level I Aggregate	0.5 day

New Structure:

Course name	Class Duration	Pre-requisite	Recertification class
Aggregate Sampler	0.5 day	None	0.5 day
Aggregate Technician	4 days	None	1 day

If you are currently **only** Level I Aggregate certified, you will now be Aggregate Sampler certified. Your certification expiration date will be the same as your current Level I certification expiration date.

If you are currently **both** Level I Aggregate certified and Level II Aggregate certified, you will now be Aggregate Technician certified. Your certification expiration date will be the same as your current Level II certification expiration date.

*Please note: new certification cards will NOT be sent at this time. Your current cards contain all the necessary information. Cards issued in Spring 2018 will reflect the changes.
